



CASWELL CENTER FOUNDATION 2011 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Caswell Center Foundation, Inc. will provide up to five \$1,000 academic scholarships for the 2011-2012 academic year to qualified applicants working toward an undergraduate and graduate degree with the intent of serving persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities. **Also, anyone who has previously received a scholarship from Caswell Center Foundation who is still in school is encouraged to re-apply under the new category that has been set up for re-applicants.** The 2011-2012 scholarships will be available to individuals residing in one of the following 38 counties: Beaufort, Bertie, Bladen, Brunswick, Camden, Carteret, Chowan, Columbus, Craven, Cumberland, Currituck, Dare, Duplin, Edgecombe, Gates, Greene, Hertford, Hyde, Johnston, Jones, Lenoir, Martin, Nash, New Hanover, Northampton, Onslow, Pamlico, Pasquotank, Pender, Perquimans, Pitt, Robeson, Sampson, Scotland, Tyrrell, Washington, Wayne or Wilson.

A high school senior must meet the following eligibility criteria to apply for the undergraduate scholarship:

- Intend to seek an undergraduate degree in Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Recreation Therapy, Psychology, Pre-Medical Special Education, Nursing, Speech-Language Pathology or Social Work.
- Intend to work with persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities after college graduation.
- Be accepted at an accredited college or university.
- Have a high school grade point average of 2.8 or higher

A high school senior must submit the following to apply for the scholarship:

- Freshman Scholarship Application Form
- Letter of acceptance from college/university.
- Two letters of reference, one of which must be from a teacher.
- OFFICIAL High School Transcript.

An undergraduate or graduate student must meet the following eligibility criteria to apply for his/her respective scholarship:

- Be a full-time undergraduate or graduate student.
- Have an undergraduate cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher, or a graduate cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- Continue to major in one of the degree programs cited above with the intent to work with persons with developmental disabilities.
- Demonstrate evidence of volunteer (or paid) experience working with persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

An undergraduate or graduate student must submit the following to apply for the scholarship:

- Undergraduate or Graduate Scholarship Application Form; graduate school acceptance letter if applicable.
- Recommendation letters from volunteer experience or previous employer.
- OFFICIAL Transcript.
